**INTERMEDIATE (A)**  
**GREEK LANGUAGE AND CULTURE**

**OBJECTIVES:**

To assist students with a basic knowledge of Modern Greek:

- to formalize and enhance knowledge of Greek
- to improve skills in reading, writing and speaking the language
- to discuss aspects of the Greek culture from an historical, religious and customary aspect

**PREREQUISITES:** This is a course for students who have attended the Introduction Course (all three terms) in 2017. New students will also be admitted provided their knowledge of Greek is to this level of competency to be determined by an informal testing.

**DURATION:** 12 weeks per term  
Term 1 – February to May 2018  
Term 2 – May to August 2018  
Term 3 – August to November 2018

**DAY AND TIME:** Wednesday 6:00pm – 8:00pm

**FEE:** \$180.00 per term (3 terms per year)  
Term 2 is continuation of Term 1 and Term 3 is continuation of Term 2

To attend the classes you need to be a Hellenic Club Member.

Courses are conducted over three (3) 12-week terms.

The courses are held at the Hellenic Club, Woden.
